Reflect on how God speaks to our world today, to the situations we are facing as individuals, as a church, as a country, and as the world God so loves.

And then the Philistines were back at it again, plundering in the valley. David again prayed to God. God answered, "This time don't attack head-on; circle around and come at them out of the balsam grove. When you hear a sound like shuffling feet in the tops of the balsams, attack; God will be two steps ahead of you," (I Chronicles 14:14-16)

The way you did it last time worked well, but, "<u>This time</u> - don't attack head-on; circle around and come at them out of the balsam grove... God will be two steps ahead of you." I love it. God gives them a new way, gives the details, then goes ahead them.

Life is full of surprises, some "same old same old's", some "new opportunities," some "more of the same's," and – "some changes." "It worked last time, it should work this time, too." We are just not fond of change. But the only constant in life - is change. How we face it defines our future. Will we be victorious? Can we make the new way work? Can we trust God to be in control of this new plan? Will God go ahead of us this time, too?

We may not know where we are going. What is waiting around the corner? How we can make it through an unexpected turn of events. For some, things may not be going according to their plan, but we pray for God's will - not ours. We <u>can</u> trust God to be two steps ahead of us.

It's 9 am on Wednesday and the race for President has not yet been called. God raises up leaders for God's purpose. We pray for a peaceful resolution to the counting. May the result be accepted by everybody. May all Americans stand united behind the winner when he is announced so peace may come over the citizens. There will be some new elected Representatives, Senators, local legislators, Governors and a variety of other elected officials today. Some of our candidates won and some lost. Our trust, however, remains in God - and God goes ahead of us

No matter what changes we face, God's character does not change. And what God's asks of us does not change. God remains, "gracious and full of compassion, slow to anger and abounding in steadfast love." (Psalm 145:8)

Some things remain the same, some things change, but God's love for us never changes. God's desire for us to be kind, to forgive, to love one another - never changes. In the middle of change is a good time to remember how we are to imitate Christ. How important it is, for the good of the World God so loves, for us to come together, be unified and work for peace in our country. Just because it didn't go our way, or because it is different, or because it is divisive – doesn't mean God is not in it.

God remains in control. We pray for God's will to be done, for we trust in the God who has gone before us.

Our God is a creative God, sometimes the old way won't work this time and we need to try something different. After all, God has laid it all out and has gone before us. In God we trust.

Let us pray.

Lord, we ask for peace and unity for our country as we face the future. May we seek Your will, trusting You have gone before us. We pray for our newly elected and re-elected leaders, give them Your wisdom and compassion as they lead. We pray for peaceful transitions. May we all give our elected officials respect as they govern our states and our country. Thank you for this country and we pray, God, bless America. Amen.




