When you pass through the waters, I will be with you; and through the rivers, they shall not overwhelm you; (Isa 43:2)

I love water metaphors. I often feel like I'm lost at sea. I'm always going against the current. I'm alone in my boat. God talks about water a lot in scripture. The earth was covered with water. People were always going into the water. They escaped Egypt and slavery through the rivers of the Red Sea. They entered the promise land though the waters of the Jordan. Many of Jesus' disciples were fishermen, they made their living on the water. Jesus walked on water, stilled storms at sea, turned water into wine. Many of Jesus' teachings were set on the water. Lessons were learned, miracles performed, illustrations were made in - and on the water. Jesus is for us living water.
