A Word on Wednesday from Pastor Tonia "God IS With Us" 9/14/22

I have told you these things, so, in Me you may have peace. In this world you will have trouble. But take heart! I have overcome the world. (John 16:33)

We learn through the obstacles we face in life. Tough times, difficult situations make us stronger. The obstacles are the way. We don't like it. Do not want to deal with. Would rather turn around and go back to a more comfortable place. But by facing difficulties we become more resilient, we come to know ourselves and what we can accomplish. We surprise others, we surprise ourselves. This isn't a downer tale. It's life. And life IS good. God IS present. In James we are told, "Blessed is the one who perseveres under trial because, having stood the test, that person will receive the crown of life which the Lord has promised to those who love Him." (James 1:12)

The Lord loves each of us and knows our future, and it is one with hope. Hang on to this. Have hope. Keep the faith. God is present, today, tomorrow, and always. Go ahead, face the difficulties. God has overcome the world, God is with us, and He's got this.
