A Word on Wednesday from Pastor Tonia "Please God" 9/20/23

Do not worry about anything, but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving, let your requests be made known to God. (Phil 4:6)

It seems like most prayers begin with, "Please, God." Give me this, do that. Our prayers don't so much change God's mind, but they do form ours. We are to, as John Wesley succinctly put it, "Please God. Do good. Love others."

Maybe instead of praying "Please, God," I need, I want, give me, see that, do this," we set out each day to "Please God." We know God will show Himself in the nature which surrounds us, in the people we meet, in the situations we run into."

Look around, look up and see God in the green trees against the blue sky, be in awe of the waves rushing in, look at the wildflowers, really see the colors of a sunset, listen to the birds, be in wonder of the honeybee, feel a cat's purr. So thankful. Smile when the neighbor drops off some cookies, feel the love when a friend calls just to see how you are, be filled with love as you look around at the people you love in church worshipping together as one, hug your loved one, feel content as you look around your home, smile as you look at a picture of an old friend. So much to be thankful for. God blesses us and for that we give thanks.

Give thanks for your job, for the ability to work, give thanks you are able to stay home and raise your children. Give thanks for your vacation, for a retreat, a family reunion, for time off or away. Give thanks for your food, for its source, and the ability to enjoy it. Give thanks for your place of shelter. For those who come into your life. Praise God for all of His gifts, for His unfailing love. Please God with your prayers, knowing He is always there to hear you and to give to you what is best for you.
